

The Armstrongs have reported more than 100 birds in his backyard this year. They share this list but reminds us that Red Rock State Park has a more comprehensive list for the Loop area.

Birds seen everyday include

- house finches & lesser goldfinches
- gila, hairy, ladderback woodpeckers
- mourning & collared doves (inca usually 2 houses away)
- summer tanagers
- black-headed grosbeak
- brown-crested flycatcher (also have ash-throated sometimes)
- black phoebe
- hooded & bullock's orioles
- bridled titmice
- great blue heron (nesting)
- common black hawk (nest visible from yard)
- song sparrow
- robin
- black-chinned & anna's hummingbirds
- white-throated swift (nest on cliffs)
- violet-green swallow
- lucy's & yellow warblers
- common yellowthroat
